ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Sana @ Karishma and Rasin Khan, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 10 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 10. They have placed on record Nikhannama Annexures P-4 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 02.04.2019, Annexure P- 5 to respondent No.2.

Respondent No.4, who is father of petitioner-Sana @ Karishma, is represented by his counsel and has also spoken to his daughter. He satisfied that his daughter Sana @ Karishma is happy with petitioner No.2. He undertakes that he would not be instrumental in creating any hurdle in the married life of petitioners No.1 and 2.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with

directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-5 within a period of one month and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
