This petition was filed by petitioner Harnam Singh under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 for registering a FIR against the private respondents No.7 to 10.

The grievance of the petitioner pertains to the alleged act of the private respondents, who are his neighbours, whereby they have attempted to encroach upon the plot, owned by the petitioner. The petitioner gave a complaint to the Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka, as alleged in para 11 of the petition.

Ever since from filing of the petition, no interest has been shown by the petitioner as every time a prayer for adjournment has been made on those few occasions when someone has represented the petitioner.

On most of the occasions the petitioner is not represented by anyone.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C., particularly, when an alternative remedy in law is available to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
