On 09.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioners claim that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 13.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel is directed to file the status report on the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 03.05.2019.

In the meantime, respondent No.3 after considering the threat perception would provide security to the petitioners.”

A status report has been filed by the State counsel and on instructions from ASI Jiwan Singh, has asserted that statements of petitioner No.1-Sunita, respondent No.4-Kinder and Karanjit Kaur who is wife of Gopi-respondent No.8 has been recorded and all have stated that there is no

apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioners nor they want any action.

Counsel for the petitioners is not present.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file a fresh application, if there is any threat to their life and liberty.
