On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Vashisth, DAG,
Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that
petitioner was granted 15 days parole from 8.4.2019 to 22.4.2019 by
Divisional Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak vide order dated
18.2.2019. He further contends that now the said parole has been cancelled
on account of enforcement of model Code of Conduct.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that delivery
of the wife of petitioner is due on 9.4.2019. Therefore, it is an emergent
situation.

After hearing learned counsel for both the parties; considering
that parole was granted on 18.2.2019 and the presence of the petitioner is

required to provide assistance and support to his wife, it is ordered that notwithstanding any order to the contrary and notwithstanding the Model Code of Conduct, petitioner on account of the said medical ground be released on parole on his furnishing adequate surety in terms of the said order.
