[1] Perusal of Order dated 29.11.2019 reveals that as per the result of the petitioner produced by learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana in sealed cover envelop, the petitioner secured 13.60 marks out of 80 in the written examination, 04 out of 04 marks for Graduation, 03 out of 03 marks for Post-Graduation, and 0 mark out of 03 marks on account of NCC, besides 0 mark out of 10 on account of socio-economic criteria and experience, i.e. a grand total 20.60 marks out of 100 marks for the post of Female Constable (General Duty) in Police Department, Haryana in respect of Advertisement No.03/2018, Category No.2, whereas the last candidate selected in the category in which, the petitioner had applied i.e. ESM (General) Ex-servicemen Dependant Category secured 28 marks.

[2] Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition.

[3] In view of the position as noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn.***
