Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.01 dated 07.01.2018 (P-1), under Sections 308, 341, 323, 34, 325, 379 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Amir Khas, District Ferozepur.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 11.04.2019 in the main petition, passed the following order:-

“ Prayer in this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case, FIR No.01 dated 07.01.2018, registered under Sections 308, 341, 323, 34, 325 and 379 IPC, Police Station Amir Khas, District Ferozepur.

According to the prosecution, on 04.12.2017, the petitioner along with his accomplice Neetu, Ranjit Ram, Pappu

etc. caused injuries to the complainant with baseball bat and lathis etc.

Learned counsel contends that petitioner is an old lady, aged around 62 years. She has been attributed only fists blow. No recovery is to be effected from her. All other co-accused of the petitioner have been granted regular bail.

Notice of motion for 29.07.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, ASI Om Parkash, who is present in the Court, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 11.04.2019 and her custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 11.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
