CRM-M No.16446 of 2019

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.128, dated 25.03.2019, registered under Sections 409, 420, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 7 and 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, at Police Station Kaithal City, District Kaithal.

Reply has been filed in the petition for quashing of the instant FIR filed by the petitioner bearing CRM-M No.19866 of 2019. It has been mentioned in the reply that investigation in this case has not yet started

because prosecution sanction has not been received.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
