ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 217 dated 25.11.2018, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the offence under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 is a bailable offence, she may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and further prays that the trial Court may be directed in case the petitioner moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above limited prayer of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case the petitioner surrenders before it within a period of seven days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided within a period of two days thereafter.
