Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail pending trial in case FIR No. 165 dated 22.11.2017, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Division No.2, Jalandhar.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he confines his prayer only to the extent that learned trial Court may directed to expedite the trial.

The prayer seems to be justified and accepted. Since, the FIR was registered way back in the year 2017, therefore, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of three months positively from today.
