Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.16/18 dated 20.10.2018 under Section 3 of Railways Property (Unlawful Possession) Act, 1966, registered at Police Station RPF, District Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 12.04.2019: -

“.....Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the main accused, namely Gurjant Singh @ Tittu, stands arrested and he has admitted that he has committed many thefts of smoke tables.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner was earlier granted interim anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, vide order dated 28.02.2019, however,

the same was dismissed on 13.03.2019, though the petitioner has joined investigation.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
