Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to take necessary legal action against respondent Nos. 3 to 7, on the representation dated 31.07.2017, submitted by the petitioner, for registration of the FIR.

Reply, by way of affidavit of DSP City-II, Bathinda, has been filed in Court today. As per the reply, ASI Major Singh, on 17.09.2016, on receiving a call that dead body of one Deepak Kumar is lying in the Dead House, Civil Hospital, Fazilka, reached there and met Gagandeep Kaur w/o deceased Deepak Kumar and recorded her statement. Thereafter, after recording her statement, proceedings under Section 174 Cr.P.C. were conducted and after the postmortem was conducted by the board of doctors, the dead body was handed over to the relatives of the deceased. It is further stated in the reply that on receiving the complaint, SSP, Bathinda marked an inquiry to DSP City-II, Women, Bathinda and a detailed inquiry was

conducted in which the statements from the side of the petitioner were recorded. It is further stated that as per the inquiry report (copy attached as Annexure R/T-5), no substance was found in the allegations levelled by the petitioner and the complaint was filed.

In view of the above, since the only prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation of the petitioner which after a detailed inquiry stands decided, this petition is disposed of.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the Illaqua Magistrate for filing of a complaint, if so advised.
