After hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 4-State to ensure due protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioners and to ensure that the petitioners are not unduly put to harassment, either by the private respondents or the official respondents, in any manner. It is further directed that the official

respondents will take prompt and immediate action on the representation dated 20.03.2019 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner, uninfluenced by any external pressures. However, this would not construed as bestowing upon the petitioners any protection from legitimate action by the official respondents in accordance with law.
