Application is allowed for the reasons stated therein. Main case, i.e. CRM-M-16470 of 2019 is restored to its original number and at the oral request made by learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner, the same is taken up for hearing today itself.

CRM-M-16470 of 2019

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner, in FIR No.103 dated 24.08.2016, under Sections 399, 402, 379, 411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered

at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

On 10.04.2019, while issuing notice of motion, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Contends that this was the only first default by the petitioner due to unavoidable circumstances and he undertakes that in future, there will be no recurrence on his part.

Notice of motion for 10.05.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the proceedings before learned trial Court. In case, the petitioner joins the proceedings and moves an application for bail, he be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in terms of interim order dated 10.04.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined proceedings before learned trial Court and has also furnished necessary bail/surety bonds. He has also submitted that now the petitioner is appearing regularly before learned trial Court.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Sham Singh.

In view of the above, order dated 10.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off, accordingly.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-

operate with the learned trial Court for conducting smooth trial without seeking any unnecessary adjournments.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
