Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.4-Balkar Singh @ Gulli by the learned Additional Sessions Judge (Exclusive Court for Heinous Crimes against Women), Patiala vide order dated 26.07.2018 in FIR No.83 dated 21.06.2018 registered under Sections 354, 376 IPC at Police Station Ghagga, Tehsil Patran, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the Investigating Agency has misrepresented the facts to the court at the time of consideration of bail application of respondent No.4.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, states that the police has already completed investigation in the case and has submitted challan.

Considering the fact that the challan has been presented in the case and respondent No.4 must have been admitted on regular bail after submission of challan, the prayer of the petitioner for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.4, cannot be accepted.

Dismissed.
