On 01.07.2019, the case was adjourned as counsel for the petitioners had submitted as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the parties have entered into a compromise and respondent No.2 has undertaken to withdraw all the pending cases against the petitioners within two days. Hence, he prays for an adjournment.
