This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 20.05.2018 registered under Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 115 IPC (added later on) at P.S. Bond Kalan, District Charkhi Dadri.

Today the Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Bhiwani is present in person who states that at one time the petitioner had been confined in the District Jail, Gurugram and that record had not been made. Explanation is accepted.

Custody certificate filed in Court dated 19.05.2019 by Amit –
Dsm, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Bhiwani is taken on record, wherein it has been certified that the petitioner has been in custody for the last 8 months.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that apart from other facts the petitioner has been in custody for the last more than 8 months and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

Learned Assistant Advocate General has accepted that the petitioner has been in custody for the last more than 8 months and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned C.J.M/Illaqa Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
