The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.135, dated 27.05.2015, under Sections 326, 324, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for almost a year since 26.04.2018 and he has been attributed one grievous injury on little finger of the complainant's hand as well as other simple injuries on non-vital parts of his body, which were found simple in nature. He also contends that trial is being delayed, as the complainant had gone abroad and his statement could not be recorded.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh is not in a position to controvert the factual position.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner

especially when the petitioner is in custody for almost a year, I deem it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of regular bail as the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
