SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.176, dated 24.05.2018, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh, Mewat, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 285, 506 IPC.

According to the FIR, the petitioner allegedly trespassed into the house of the complainant past mid night and threatened him to settle the on-going dispute between the families of the complainant and the petitioner. The petitioner was also allegedly armed and fired a shot in the air.

Interim bail was granted to the petitioner, pursuant to which, he has joined investigation. However, learned State counsel has submitted that there are five other criminal cases pending against the petitioner and that he is not cooperating with the investigation. The pending cases against

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the petitioner include one under Section 302 IPC and one under Section 10 of the POCSO Act.

On being confronted with the fact that the petitioner appears to be a hardened criminal, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not in a position to explain his past conduct. However, he reiterates his submissions that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on account of a civil dispute between the families of the complainant and the petitioner.

In the petition it has been pleaded that the petitioner is 16 years and 02 months of age. Yet, there are five other criminal cases pending against him out of which 02 are for heinous offences. Thus, in my opinion, the petitioner does not deserve any discretionary relief at the hands of this Court.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
