Report dated 24.05.2019 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Faridkot has been received whereby after recording statements of petitioners Ravinder Singh @ Gurvinder Singh, Didar Singh and Balbir Kaur and complainant Gurpreet Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court

and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' **2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 134 dated 26.06.2017 registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot under Sections 498-A, 406 and 34 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
