By this order, two petitions, i.e., Criminal Misc.M-16696 of 2019 and Criminal Misc.-M-17277 of 2019 stand disposed of.

Prayer is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.430 dated 20.08.2018 registered under Sections 379-B, 411, 365, 394, 201, 397, 506 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat. First application (CRM-M-16696 of 2019) has been filed by Parveen and the second (CRM-M-17277 of 2019) has been filed by Rahul @ Ravi. Both are in custody since 14.09.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that first informant-victim did not identify the petitioners when he appeared in the Court at the time of his deposition.

Learned State counsel does not dispute this position. However,

he submits that the petitioners are involved in some other more cases.

Be that as it may. At this stage this would appropriate for this Court to not comment upon the merits of the case lest it may prejudice the trial.

Keeping in view the custody of the petitioners and argument of learned counsel for the petitioner, however, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are in custody for almost one year and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail subject to their furnishing adequate surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the petitioners are allowed with the aforesaid directions.
