Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.63 dated 23.04.2019 under Sections 323/325/341/354/354-B/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 11.04.2019 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and states that the custodial interrogation is no more required.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custody is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 11.04.2019 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
