Mr. Rahul Arora, Advocate appears on behalf of the respondent and states that the payment of Rs. 42,00,000/- (odd) have been paid to the petitioner and the balance amount of Rs.14,02,401/-. He further states that the payment would be made within ten weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made in Court today, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

In case, the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent today in Court is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

It is further clarified that in case, the petitioner is forced to revive the contempt petition, exemplary costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
