The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.31 dated 04.03.2019 under Sections 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 3/4 of the SC&ST Act, registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, Amritsar.

The operative part of the order dated 11.04.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a bare perusal of the FIR shows that there are no allegations, which could invoke the provisions of Sections 3/4 of SC&ST Act.

Notice of motion for 30.04.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 11.04.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 11.04.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
