Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty from respondents No.4 to 6 as they have entered into marriage against the wishes of private respondents.

It is mentioned in the petition that petitioners are in relation for a long time and prior to the marriage the efforts for getting consent to this marriage from the private respondents had failed. According to the pleadings, an attempt was made to get the family consent once again.

Perusal of the representation dated 05.4.2019 given by the petitioners to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana Rural, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-4) as well as the petition do not disclose the

existence of alleged threat. It is conceded that no untoward incident had ever taken place muchless at the instance of private respondents during the tenure of love affair between the petitioners.

The petition does not inspire any confidence and no convincing ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to issue any direction to the official respondents.

The petition is hereby dismissed.
