This order shall dispose of above-mentioned two petitions filed on behalf of Sanjay Kumar Chugh and Ram Rishi Parshar for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0124 dated 15.03.2018 registered under Sections 406/420 IPC and Section 3 of the Haryana Protection of Interest of Depositors in Financial establishment Act, 2013 (Haryana Act No.32 of 2014) at Police Station Sampla,

District Rohtak.

The FIR was registered on the instance of Meenu Jain wherein she alleged that she had paid Rs.5 lacs in the year 2013 for buying a Flat but despite lapse of period of more than 3 years, the construction had not started. The petitioners are stated to be Directors of M/s M2M Buildtech (P) Ltd. i.e. of the builder firm.

During the course of pendency of this petition, the petitioners have paid an amount of Rs.2.5 lacs each to the complainant.

Learned counsel representing the complainant has endorsed the fact that the complainant has indeed received an amount of Rs.5 lacs from the petitioners and has submitted that he has no objection for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court on 14.08.2018, the petitioners are stated to have joined investigation.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and that the petitioners have already joined investigation, the petitions, as such, are accepted and interim directions issued vide order dated 14.08.2018 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
