Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for directing respondents No.1 and 2 to get an inquiry conducted of the incident dated 29.07.2018 by some senior officer.

Mr. Pritam Singh Baath, Advocate appears, files *vakalatnama* on behalf of respondents No.7, 9 to 14 and the same is taken on record.

On 11.04.2019, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 24.07.2019.

Respondent No.3-SSP, Rupnagar is directed to file his affidavit regarding the investigation of FIR No.34 dated 30.07.2018 (P-1), under Sections 457, 380, IPC (Section 411, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar.”

In response to notice of motion issued by this Court, affidavit of Swapan Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar has already been filed on behalf of respondent No.3.

Perusal of the same reveals that after investigation in the matter, report under Section 173(2) Cr. P.C. was prepared on 18.08.2018 and has been submitted before the competent Court on 30.08.2018.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from police official present in Court to assist him, has apprised the Court that now the matter is pending for 14.08.2019, before learned trial Court, for consideration of charges.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter; consequently, petition stands disposed off.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law before learned trial Court where the matter is stated to be pending for consideration of charges.
