JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondent to repair, fill potholes and maintain the stretch of road connecting Chandigarh – Ambala Highway (National Highway) to Zirakpur- Parwanoo highway (National Highway).

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the sole respondent - Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Zirakpur to consider and decide the representation dated 10.3.2019 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG, Punjab, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the sole

respondent - Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Zirakpur to consider and decide the representation dated 10.3.2019 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to it, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to it, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
