GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a direction to the respondents for lodging of FIR on account of injuries having been caused to the petitioner and other members of his family.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on 21.3.2019, the petitioner and another eight members of his family were caused injuries but the police till date has not taken any action despite the fact that a written complaint dated 1.4.2019 (Annexure P-2) was also filed. Learned counsel in this context has also drawn the attention of this Court to various photographs annexed with this

petition indicating receipt of injuries by various members of petitioners family.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Six sets of petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
4. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-2) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.
5. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
