Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.101 dated 16.12.2012, registered under Sections 380, 457 and 411 IPC, at Police Station Behram, SBS Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 12.04.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 01.05.2019 along with receipts of ₹15,000/- to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, S.B.S. Nagar, has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.141 dated 13.05.2019 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, vide Endst. No.421/DSJ-101A dated 14.05.2019.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, S.B.S. Nagar, is satisfied that the compromise is genuine, valid and without any pressure or coercion in any manner. No accused has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, S.B.S. Nagar, dated 13.5.2019 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.101 dated 16.12.2012 along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner only.

Disposed of accordingly.
