Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 48, dated 28.02.2019, under Sections 498-A, 354-A IPC, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced photocopy of the compromise entered between the parties along with copy of petition dated 06.07.2019 filed by the parties under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, states that there is no intimation to the police with regard to compromise so produced by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the compromise have entered between the parties, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.05.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
