Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-bank not to proceed with the auction scheduled for 14.05.2019 in pursuance of the order dated 18.03.2019 (Annexure P-12) and the proclamation of sale deed dated 18.03.2019 (Annexure P-13) till the decision of the application dated 13.03.2019 (Annexure P-11).

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted since the petitioner has already approached the Debts Recovery Tribunal-III, Chandigarh, he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the said remedy, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
