This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in Complaint No.4/2015 instituted on 07.02.2015 vide which they have been summoned to face trial under Sections 302 read with Section 34 IPC, along with other accused.

A copy of order dated 13.08.2018 passed by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nihal Singh Wala, has been handed over by the learned counsel for the petitioners. A perusal thereof shows that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 10.08.2018, the petitioners have surrendered before the Trial Magistrate and they have been released on interim bail on acceptance of their bail and surety bonds.
