Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.138 dated 17.10.2018, under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

On 12.04.2019, while issuing notice of motion, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 08.05.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Kirpal Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of order dated 12.04.2019 and her custodial

interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, order dated 12.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off, accordingly.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
