By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.175 dated 03.07.2018, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' – for short) registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar.

On 13.08.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Notice of motion for 30.01.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the Arresting/Investigating Officer. On doing so, they shall be released on interim bail, subject to their furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, they shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which they shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to them.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance

of the order dated 13.08.2018, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Dharminder submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.08.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
