The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 7.2.2019 passed by this Court in Crl. Misc. No. M-5717 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider the representation dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary, within a period of eight weeks.”

Pursuant to the notice of motion, short reply dated 17.7.2019 by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh Chahal, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran has been filed. Along with the reply, order dated 13.3.2019 has been annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order dated 13.3.2019, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty aforesaid.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
