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Petitioners-Chatterpal and Vikram have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.168 dated 30.05.2018, registered at Police Station Uchana, Jind, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 307, 325, 506 and 341 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, the present FIR has been registered on the statement of complainant-Parvesh, who also sustained injury dangerous to life.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court that complainant-Parvesh while appearing before the trial Court has specifically stated that the accused present in the Court are not the same persons, who had caused injuries to him.

The petitioners are in custody since 01.06.2018. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
