On 12.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Manpreet Kaur and Manjinder Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent nos.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs Annexure P-3 evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have made representation dated 09.04.2019, Annexure P-5 to respondent no.2.

Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, appearing for the State of Punjab is requested to submit a status report. A copy of the petition be supplied to the State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meantime, respondent no.2 would examine the threat perceptions and if found necessary, interim protection would be provided to them. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

Adjourned to 26.04.2019."

Learned State counsel has submitted a report along with statement of the petitioners to the effect that they do not have any further threat perception. The report is taken on record.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
