Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he wishes to withdraw the present petition qua petitioners No. 1 and 2, at this stage, however, reserving the rights of both the petitioners to file a fresh one on the same very grounds.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Report dated 17.09.2018 of the learned Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Phagwara has been received whereby after recording

statements of complainant/respondent Baljit Kaur and accused/petitioners-Sawaran Singh and Baljinder Kaur, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, the private parties to this petition have put in appearance before this Court and during the course of interaction with the parties, it transpired that they have compromised the matter and resolved to end the dispute and compromised the matter as per compromise/affidavit (Annexure P-2) and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of statements made by the parties and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 53 dated 21.07.2017 registered at Police Station Satnampura under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the accused-

petitioners Sawaran Singh and Baljinder Kaur are quashed. Petition qua other petitioners stands dismissed as withdrawn.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
