AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 24.09.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.24372 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

"We thus dispose of this writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file appeal against the impugned order of the Estate Officer within a period of one month before the Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula who in turn is directed to entertain and decide the same on merits and by way of a reasoned order and after hearing the representative

of the petitioner-society. It shall be appreciated if the final order is passed within a period of four months from the date of filing the appeal.”

Reply by way of affidavit annexing order dated 24.01.2019 has been filed today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of order passed, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against order dated 24.01.2019.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
