The only allegation is that the petitioner had verified the accused who impersonated herself to be Charan Kaur w/o Surjit Singh and executed the power of attorney in favour of Kuldeep Singh.

On 12.04.2019 the following contention was noticed :-

“Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner had verified/identified Charan Kaur only on the basis of Aadhar Card.”

Today learned DAG on instructions from HC Supinder Singh
has accepted that the accused had appeared with an Aadhar Card (possibly a
fake one).

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 10.06.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
