Grievance of the petitioner is that he has not been accorded the benefit of revised pay scale as recommended by the various pay commissions from time to time with regard to the skilled and semi skilled staff serving in the Punjab Government.

2. Learned counsel also relies on a judgment dated 26.04.2018 (Annexure P-9) rendered by this Court in CWP No.7001 of 2013 and contends that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the same. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner represented the respondents by causing a legal notice dated 05.07.2018 (Annexure P-10) but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate with Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

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5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 05.07.2018 (Annexure P-10) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
