Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the order dated 10.08.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Moga as well as order dated 29.02.2016 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Moga in FIR No. 7 dated 07.01.2012, under Sections 326, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, Moga, whereby application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. filed by the prosecution/State for summoning of the respondents as additional accused was dismissed by both the Courts below.
