This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for setting aside the order dated 3.4.2019 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Nangal whereby the application filed by the petitioner for going abroad has been dismissed.

Heard.

It has been submitted that the petitioner is facing trial for offence punishable under Sections 498-A and 406 of Indian Penal Code. It has been further submitted that the trial is in progress and the case is now fixed for evidence of the prosecution.

The petitioner wishes to go abroad to serve in a Gurudwara at Australia.

To the mind of this Court, by going abroad, delay will cause

in the trial.

No case is made out for interference in the impugned order by this Court which does not suffer from any illegality, irregularity or infirmity.

Dismissed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to move fresh application for going abroad before the trial court after conclusion of the evidence.
