Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner- Balwinder Singh alias Bagga son of Mukhtiar Singh alias Makha in case F.I.R. No.97 dated 11.06.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel representing petitioner contended that the occurrence was result of matrimonial dispute which has otherwise been settled amicably on 13.03.2019 and written compromise is Annexure-P1 on the file. Otherwise also, the petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2019 and trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the period of detention of the petitioner since 12.03.2019.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration and the fact the petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2019; trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Balwinder Singh alias Bagga son of Mukhtiar Singh alias Makha, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
