The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 15.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 25155 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to look into and decide the legal notice dated 13.3.2018 (Annexure-P8) expeditiously and preferably within a period of three months in the light of judgment dated 18.1.2011 rendered by Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in CWP No. 10931 of 1990.”

Short reply dated 24.7.2019 by way of affidavit of Alok Nigam, Additional Chief Secretary, Public Works (Building and Roads) Department, Haryana was filed annexing copy of order dated 23.4.2019 along with copy of pay fixation order.

Learned counsel for the State submits that directions of this Court have been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
