AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 6.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 26903 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 3.8.2018 (Annexure P-5) and pass a speaking order in terms of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 24340 of 2016 captioned as ***Om Parkash and another vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on March 24, 2017 as well as retiral benefits within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the State submits that in pursuance to the order of this Court, retiral benefits have been calculated and the amount has been released to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that although the order has been passed in favour of the petitioner but no amount has been received by the petitioner till date.

Learned counsel for the State assures that if the payment has not been made already, the same would be made within three weeks from today.

In view of the statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, it is made clear that in case the statement made today in court is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition and in that circumstances, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.
