The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, "Cr.P.C".) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.142 dated 19.8.2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act at Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana.

Heard.

It is the case of the prosecution that the minor prosecutrix aged about 15 years was enticed and taken away by none else but her own maternal aunt namely Sapna who sold the minor prosecutrix to petitioner- Achhar Singh @ Lalli for a sum of ₹ 20,000/-. She was subjected to illicit intercourse by the petitioner so many times.

In view of the above and after going through the material available on record, this Court is of the view that the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of regular bail.

Dismissed.
