AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0273 dated 19.06.2018 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

On 14.08.2018 the following order was passed:-

“Sarabjit Singh aged 22 years committed suicide by consuming poisonous substance. He was in love with Ramandeep Kaur petitioner but Ramandeep Kaur and her mother were not agreeing to the same. It is further allegation that he had gone to their house and when he came back, he was vomiting and was admitted in the hospital where he died.

Notice of motion for 21.1.2019.

Mr. P.S.Miglani, Advocate has appeared for the complainant.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of their arrest being required, they shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to their furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, they shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which they shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to them.”

Learned Senior Deputy Advocate General on instructions from Investigating Officer accepts the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has objected to the bail.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 14.08.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
