The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.27 dated 23.03.2019 registered under Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

The operative part of the order dated 12.04.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant approached the petitioner for taking a shop on rent, however, the petitioner refused to rent out the same by saying that since the petitioner belong to S.C. category, he is not ready to rent out the building on rent. Notice of motion for 25.04.2019.”

SI Surinder Singh, who is present in Court, submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 12.04.2019, has already joined investigation and he is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim

bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 12.04.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
