This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioners Sukhpreet Singh alias Sukh and Devinder Singh Bhullar in case bearing FIR No.81 dated 29.04.2018 registered at Police Station Kartarpur, Police District Jalandhar under Sections 354, 354-A, 323, 379-B, 365, 506, 511 IPC and sections 8 and 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 22.04.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and have been released on bail, and has placed on record photostat copy of the order dated 04.05.2019 which is not displaced by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 22.04.2019 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
